*Every student upon enrollment is given the TSI (Texas Success Initiative) on the first day. The Texas Success Initiative Assessment, better known as the TSI test, is a program which determines the appropriate level of college course work for an incoming student. The TSI test consists of three separate exams: Mathematics, Reading, and Writing.*

*This assessment is a series of questions that help predict what classes are best suited for student needs. All college students in Texas will complete this test unless they meet exemption criteria.*

*The purpose of the Texas Success Initiative (TSI) is to determine if students are ready for college-level work in the areas of reading, writing and math. Success in these areas can help students complete their college degree or certificate program.*
